

Relaxed Performances at the Scottish Storytelling Centre

We want you to have a great time during your visit, and to keep you safe during your time with us. We ask that:

- You try to keep a 1m distance from other groups
- If you are over 12, wear a face covering (unless exempt)
- Use the hand sanitizers on entry, and wash your hands frequently.
- If you have any questions, please ask a member of staff!



Entry:

- When you arrive, you can join the queue in the storytelling court along the exhibition wall
- Your tickets will be scanned by a member of staff. You can use your e-tickets in your confirmation email, or ask our reception team to print them if you do not have a smartphone.
- We have introduced allocated seating for 2021 to allow for distancing between groups, and your seat information can be found in your confirmation email.
- A member of staff will make an announcement when the theatre is open

As part of our relaxed performances:

- There will be an audience chill out area within the building - please ask a member of staff if you'd like to use this space before the show. The room will be a quiet space with dimmed lights away from the busier areas of the building.
- During relaxed performances, audience members have permission to move around the space, leave their seat or the performance space, and can make noise.
- Audience members can also engage with the performer(s) on stage
- Audience members are welcome to see the performance space before the show, and meet the performers ahead of the show.
